No rescheduling, excuse for absence and/or provision for making-up final examinations will occur without the approval (in writing) of the dean of the student's school (A&S students-see residential dean). Such approval shall be made only for illness certified by a physician, participation in authorized University activities, and/or personal emergencies such as death in the family.
